

CHARACTER OF THE PARISH

Defining the character of the Parish can help the whole community to feel more involved in the planning process. Only if you understand the character of a place, can you identify the impacts of new developments upon that place. This applies to both positive and negative features.

Would you be able to help with this work? We need volunteers who can look at a small area and answer a number of preset questions such as: are there important views from the place; are there key features such as original windows; is the housing cramped or spacious - those sorts of questions.



NON DESIGNATED ASSETS

The Parish has 69 Listed Buildings. However there may well be buildings or structures that you know of that are important to the history or character of the Parish that are not Listed. They can be given protection by being designated as Non Heritage Assets. Can you help us by identifying such buildings or structures? They may be structures such as walls, chimneys, gates or buildings.



THE WELLS HOUSES

The Wells Houses are a very unusual and special feature of our Parish. Do you think they should be included in a new Conservation Area? This would have the affect of requiring most works undertaken to them to be the subject of an application to the Local Authority. This could help to retain key features such as original windows, doorways and thatched roofs.
