Page 14 –

### 3.4.2 Natural environment

Suggest an opening sentence to say “One of the special features of the parish is its broad range of wildlife habitats, connected by a network of corridors. These habitats include lowland heath SSSI to the south, streams, ponds and wetlands, hedgerows and mature trees (especially veteran oaks) leading to drier, acid sandstone ridges on the higher altitudes”

Page 24

Policy H6

iv Biodiversity, wildlife and its habitat and areas of connectivity must be conserved,,,”

Page 27 – Policy EH3

EH 3.1 “provide important connections between the south downs and the Weald..”

EH 3.2 - ...”ensure effective long-term management and enhancement of key features within the biodiversity corridors”
