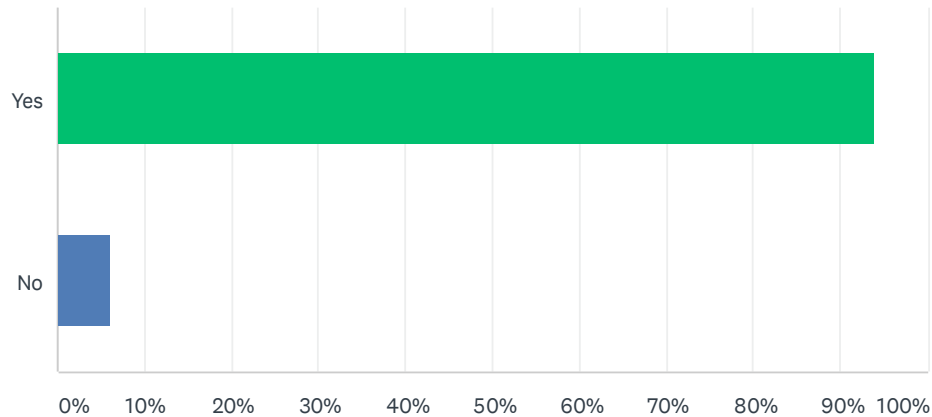


Q13 Do you agree with the policies in this section?
